

Options For Replacing One Tooth

Dental implants, dental bridges or partial dentures can be solutions for replacing missing teeth.



SINGLE TOOTH REPLACEMENT OPTIONS



DENTAL IMPLANTS

Dental implants are titanium fixtures, surgically fastened to your jawbone below the gums, onto which artificial teeth can be mounted. Over several months, implants fuse to your bone through a process called "osseointegration." This process provides stable support you can rely on while eating and speaking.

BENEFITS

- Most effective option to replace missing teeth
- Provides a natural look and feel
- No involvement of neighboring teeth so adjacent teeth remain intact
- Permanent, lifelong replacement
- Can clean implant like a normal tooth



DENTAL BRIDGE

Dental bridges are commonly used when a patient has lost one or more teeth. They are called bridges because they consist of one or more replacement teeth that bridge the gap that was created when the original teeth became lost. Dental bridges can be secured using abutment crowns on each end or by using permanently installed precision metal mechanisms. We custom design each component of a dental bridge to ensure that it looks natural and provides the desired performance. Dental bridges need to be cleaned effectively to prevent decay and infection.

PARTIAL DENTURES
